Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were On November 12, 2025 2 Children, Aged 3 and 4 Left the Class Unnoticed and Were Found on the Playground Unharmd After a 2 Minute Search by the Admin. The Children Were Unharmd. (2), A Caregiver Onsite Had Expired Fingerprints and Was Directly Working with a Group of Infants Alone. (1), and The Grass on All Playgrounds Is Tall. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
