Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Milk Fridge in the Food Prep Area Is Missing a Theromometer for Daily Monitoring. The Mini Fridge in Room 220 Reads 57 Degrees F. (2), 2 Cribs in 217 (A) Are Being Used as Storage for Bouncers. (1), and Boxes of Cinnamon Toast Crunch and Gallons of Apple Juice Are Stored Directly on the Floor in the Food Prep Area. Food Should Be Stored 6 Inches From the Floor. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
