Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were One 4 Year Old Child Was Out of Ratio at 0 Staff to 1 Child When Staff Went to Help Another Child on Playground That Had Got Hurt and This Child Was Left in Classroom Restroom. (4) and In the Owls Restroom Room on Top of the Plastic Drawer Storage Unit by the Door Was a Package of Wipes and the Package States Keep Out of Reach of Children and Was Accessible to Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
