(2), Director Self Reported on 4/7/26- Video of Caregiver Grabbing a 2 1/2 Yr Old Child's Arm Restricting Movement, Hitting Child with Her Hand on the Arm. Caregiver Is Heard on Video Yelling at the Child. Director Self Reported on 4/6/26- Caregiver Grabbing a 6 Yr Old Child's Wrist to Move From One Loc (1), and In the School Age Room the Back Restroom Dispenser Was Empty of Toilet Tissue and the Paper Towel Dispenser Was Empty. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
