Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Upon Arrival There Was Only One Caregiver with the Children. She Did Not Have Current CPR Training, It Was Expired. (1), No Documentation of Recent Fire Drills at Program, Fire Drill Log Posted Is Blank. (1), and Program Putting 12-24 Month Olds Asleep on Cots. Children Under 24 Months Old Must Sleep in a Crib or Pack N Play. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

The licensee may use washable cots, sleeping bags, or mats for toddlers over two

- **No Documentation of Recent Fire Drills at Program, Fire Drill Log Posted Is Blank.**
