Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Program Self Reported Incident of Inappropriate Discipline to DCS - Teacher Grabbed Child by the Face. Teacher's Employment Was Terminated. (1), Staff File Reviewed Did Not Have Documentation of Physical Examination. (1), and Staff File Reviewed Did Not Have Documentation of Drug Testing Results. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Caregivers shall determine maximum group size by the age of the youngest child

● **At Time of Inspection Room 149 Was Out of Ratio in the Tree Room with Nine Age 1/2 Children to One Caregiver. Ratio in a Group with a 1 Year Old Is 1:5.**

Children are under direct supervision at all times; during nap time child/staff

● **Program Self Reported Incident of Inappropriate Discipline to DCS - Teacher Grabbed Child by the Face. Teacher's Employment Was Terminated.**
