Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Two Infants Were Sleeping Behind a Closed/locked Door. (2), Two Staff with Expired TB Documentation. (1), and Items Labeled "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" Were Accessible to Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Two Staff with Expired TB Documentation.**

● **Childcare Home Is Out of Ratio. Seven Children Present Under 16 Months of Age.**
