Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Provider Does Not Have a Discipline Policy Included in Children Files (1), There Were No Fire Drill Documentation on Premesis (1), and Provider Had Cleaners Under Kitchen Sink That Were Accessible to Children and Some in the Bathroom on the Sink and Under the Sink (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
