Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were At Time of Visit Four Classrooms Were Missing Current Lesson Plans (Ladybugs, Honeybees, Ducks, Butterflies). (1), -Honeybees Bathroom Had a Diaper, and a Roll of Paper Towel Stored on Shelf Open to Air; -Ducks Bathroom Had Diapers, a Towel, Underwear, and Toilet Paper Stored Open to Air. (1), and During Visit Staff Member in Honeybees Room Did Not Wash Child's Hands After Diaper Change Until Being Reminded by Consultant. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **During Visit Staff Member in Honeybees Room Did Not Wash Child's Hands After Diaper Change Until Being Reminded by Consultant.**

● **Items Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Accessible as Follows: -Bunnies Room: Teacher Bag with Visible Medication Bottle in Cabinet Behind a Deterrent, and Plaster of Paris in an Unlocked Cabinet Under Sink; -Ladybugs Room: Swiffer Wet Jet Mop with Bottle of Antibacterial Cleaner Attached; Mur**

The center must store cleaning equipment, cleaning agents, aerosol cans, and any

● **At Time of Visit Two Out of Ten Child Files Viewed Did Not Have Documentation of Current Immunizations.**

Within thirty (30) days of a child's enrollment, the child's health record shall c
