(2), Self-report/Complaint: Director States on 10/8/25 Proper Safe Sleep Was Not Followed When a PTQ Rater Observed a 5-month-old Male Child Asleep in the Crib with a Pacifier Tether Attached to the Child's Clothes. (1), and 10 Child Files Are Missing the Signed Parent Notices in Their Files. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
