● 5 Important

Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Two Infants Present. Bottle in Refrigerator Was Not Labeled with Child's Name. (1), During Visit a 7-month Old Male Infant Was Placed in a High Chair Without Using the Seat Belt. (1), and Back Door Was Locked and Had a Latch at Top of Door Making It Inoperable During an Emergency. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Back Door Was Locked and Had a Latch at Top of Door Making It Inoperable During an Emergency.**

All approved exit doors shall be operable from the inside without the use of a k

● **At Time of Visit There Was No Caregiver Onsite with Documentation of Current First Aid/cpr Training; Both Caregivers Expired 12/2025.**

At least one (1) direct child care provider shall be trained in pediatric cardio

● **Items Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children Were Accessible at Diaper Changing Area: Aquaphor, Other Diaper Creams.**

Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,

● **Two Infants Present. Bottle in Refrigerator Was Not Labeled with Child's Name.**

If more than one (1) infant or toddler in care is bottle fed, all bottles shall

● **During Visit a 7-month Old Male Infant Was Placed in a High Chair Without Using the Seat Belt.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds
