(2), The Bottles in the Turtles and Penguins Are Not Labeled with Name, Date and Time Made Making Them Unable to Be Determined if Used Within 24 Hours of Making. (1), and Seahorses Room Has Visable Dirt on Changing Table and Wall by Changing Table. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
