Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Trash Can Lids Must Be on Any Trash Can That Contains Food Waste. Lid in Kitchen Was Not on Full Trash Can, Sitting Next to It. (2), Caregivers in Infant-two's Room Did Not Have on Apron/smock or Have a Hair Restraint on While Assisting with Lunch Service. (1), and One Caregiver Present with Children Does Not Have Documentation of First Aid Training. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
