(1), Complaint on 10/15/25, Attendance Records Missing Caregivers Time in and Out, Children's Ages, Children's Times of End of Day Pick Up and Transitions From Classroom to Playground. (1), and Complaint on 10/15/25, Video Showed 1 Caregiver with 4 Two Year Olds on the Playground with Back Turned to Children and Talking Across Walkway to Another Caregiver When Injury Occurred for One Two Year Old.
