Consent Forms and Fingerprints Must Be Submitted and Cleared Before Being with Children in Ratio. (1), Eleven (11) Month Old Male Asleep on a Cot. Safe Sleep Recommended Practices Require All Infants Under Twelve (12) Months to Sleep in a Crib. (1), and In the Catepillar Room, There Was a Child on a Cot Under the Teachers Counter Area. He Was Playing with an Electrical Cord. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
