Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were A Provider Shall: Ensure That All Employees and Volunteers Follow the Child Discipline Policy (2), At Time of Visit, Consultant Observed a Staff Member in Precious Panda's Room Did Not Wash a Child's Hands After Diaper Change. (2), and Crib in Loveable Lambs Room Was Pushed Against Diapering Table, Making It Contaminated. There Should Be a Two Foot Contamination Area Surrounding the Diapering Table. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
