(1), Toilet Paper Was Seen on Top of the Dispenser in the Following Bathrooms: Rockets, Jeeps, and Wagons. (1), and 1 Gallon of Milk Was on the Shelf in the Submarines Room and 1 Half-gallon of Lactose Free Milk Was on the Shelf of the Wagons Room Not Discarded After Being Served. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
