Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Home Missing Fire Drill Log/documentation. (1), Two of Six Children Need Birth Documentation on File. (1), and One of Six Qualified Workers Need a Physical. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Jan 13, 2025 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **Two of Six Staff Members Have a Drug Screen Result That Does Not Have MRO Information on It. All Drug Screens Must Have a MRO.**

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available

● **Two of Six Children Need Birth Documentation on File.**

Birth Certificate documentation

● **One of Six Qualified Workers Need a Physical.**

Direct child care providers who work in the home more than three (3) times a mon

● **One of Six Children Need a Signed Physical on File.**

Within thirty (30) days of a childs admission, the licensee shall receive a writ
