Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Bathroom Between Rooms 7 and 8 Had a Swiffer Mop and a Broom Stored; Bathroom in Room 6 Had Clothing Items Stored Open to Air on a Shelf. (1), Items Labeled 'Keep Out of Reach of Children' Were Accessible as Follows: -Room 6 Had MaxGel Drain Cleaner Under Sink in Bathroom, and Desitin, Meijer Diaper Rash Relief Cream, and Powder Under Changing Table Behind a Deterrent; -Room 7 Had Ajax Dish Soap Under Bathroom Sink Behind a Deterrent, And (1), and Sanitation Standards (1).
