(1), One Staff Member Missing Current Annual TB Test Results. (1), and Room 1, Room 4, and Room 9 All Had Plungers Being Stored in the Bathroom. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

- **One Staff Member Missing Current Annual TB Test Results.**
Within thirty (30) days of employment, newly employed staff, volunteers, substit
