(HH, TH, SB) Documentation Will Need to Be Provided (1), and Unless the Provider Is a Parent, Stepparent, Guardian, Custodian, or Other Relative to Each Child in the Care of the Provider, the Individual Annually Must Recieve at Least Twelve (12) Hours of Continuing Education Approved by the Division and Related to the Age Appropriate Education Development, Ca (1).
