Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Universal Precautions Expired for 1 Caregiver. \*Send Documentation. (1), Water Temperature 140 Degrees at Time of Visit. (1), and Deep Freezer Blocking Exit Door in Kitchen at Time of Visit. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Exits shall not be blocked in the child care home

● **Water Temperature 140 Degrees at Time of Visit.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

● **Fence Panel Missing in Fenced Play Yard at Time of Visit.**

The licensee shall provide a protected outdoor play area that is safely enclosed
