Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Provider Shall Provide for a Safe Environment by Ensuring That No Conditions Exist in or on the Grounds of the Facility Where a Provider Operates a Child Care Program That Would Endanger the Health, Safety, or Welfare of the Children, Including Ensuring That the Following Items Are Placed in Areas (1), All Opened Food Containers in Frige and Freezer Should Be Labeled with the Date They Are Opened (1), and The Provider Shall Have, and Maintain Compliance With, a Written Policy Describing the Practice of the Provider Concerning Safe Conditions in the Facility and on the Grounds.
