Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Items Are Stacked Up Inside of the Home in Which Could Fall on Children. These Items Include Storage Containers, Random Items, Litter Box for a Cat Accessible, Cat Litter, The Home Is Cluttered. (2), The Kitchen Counters Are Covered with Items Laying Around All Over Them and the Surface Is Not Clean. The Food Preparation Area Has Items Laying All Around It on the Floor and Stacked. Cooking Utensils, Pots/pans, Etc Are Laying Around on the Floor. Random Items Are in the Sink and Dish Drain. (1), and No Covered Container for Diapers That Are Changed for a 16 Month Old Child Present. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **The Kitchen Counters Are Covered with Items Laying Around All Over Them and the Surface Is Not Clean. The Food Preparation Area Has Items Laying All Around It on the Floor and Stacked. Cooking Utensils, Pots/pans, Etc Are Laying Around on the Floor. Random Items Are in the Sink and Dish Drain.**

Direct child care providers shall wash and sanitize all food preparation areas,

- **No Covered Container for Diapers That Are Changed for a 16 Month Old Child Present.**

Licensee shall supply a covered container for wet or soiled diapers

- **Items Are Stacked Up Inside of the Home in Which Could Fall on Children. These Items Include Storage Containers, Random Items, Litter Box for a Cat Accessible, Cat Litter, The Home Is Cluttered.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

- **Items Are Stacked Up Inside of the Home in Which Could Fall on Children. These Items Include Storage Containers, Random Items, Litter Box Containing Cat Feces and Urine, Cat Litter, Cleaning Supplies, a Bottle and Sippy Cup with Old Liquids in a Metal Basket on the Kitchen Floor, Totes.
