Room 5 Had Paper Towels on the Back of the Sink, Not on a Dispenser and Toilet Paper Stored Open in the Bathroom. Room 10 Had Toilet Paper on Top of the Dispenser, None in the Dispenser. (1), A Bin of Diaper Creams, Desitin, and Aquaphor All Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children Were Found Accessible to Children in the Zebra Room Under the Changing Table Behind a Child Deterrent. (1), and 2 Infants Missing Feeding Plans Prior to Admission. Send Documentation to Consultant. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
