(1), One Staff Member Currently Working with Children Has Expired Fingerprints on File with the Division. (1), and Each Childcare Provider, Household Member, Employee, Volunteer Caregiver Shall Submit Fingerprints for a National Criminal History Background Check by the FBI or Each Childcare Provider Has Local Criminal Check with Documentation That National Check Is Applied For.
