Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Bathrooms in the Smurfs Room Do Not Vent. (1), Pooh Bears Room Did Not Have a Lid on the Trash Can with Diapers in It. In the Muppets Room, the Trash Can Had Food Refuse but No Lid. (1), and In the Carebear Classroom, Sani-spray Was Located Under the Sink, Accessible to Children. In the Smurfts, Disinfectant Spray Is Under the Diaper Table and Is Accessible to Children. These Items State Keep Out of Reach of Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
