Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Had Soaps and Detergents Under the Sink with a Deterrant but It Was Not Locked. THE Provider Perfumes and Lotions in the Bedroom That Are in Reach of Children and Door Is Not Locked. THE Provider Removed the Items and Put Them Out of Reach of the Children. (1), The Provider Needs to Notify the Fire Department of Her Daycare and How Many Children and Ages in Care. (1), and The Provider Does Not Have an Additonal Ixtinguisher for the Kitchen. (1).
