Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Wheelbarrow Full of Wood Posts and Items, Cardboard Boxes, Pool Ladder, Several Piles of Dog Poop, Etc. Accessible to Children in the Fenced Yard at Time of Visit. (2), Medication, Batteries, Etc. in Kitchen Drawer Accessible to Children at Time of Visit. Chemicals Under Deck Accessible Children in Fenced Back Yard at Time of Visit. (1), and Fire Extinguisher in Basement Not Accessible and 1 Fire Extinguisher Expired in Kitchen at Time of Visit. \*Send Documentation. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Lock Not Installed on Gate at Time of Visit and Holes in Two Chain Link Fence Sections at Time of Visit.**  
All inground or nonportable aboveground swimming pools accessible to children sh
- **Medication, Batteries, Etc. in Kitchen Drawer Accessible to Children at Time of Visit. Chemicals Under Deck Accessible Children in Fenced Back Yard at Time of Visit.**  
Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,
- **Fire Extinguisher in Basement Not Accessible and 1 Fire Extinguisher Expired in Kitchen at Time of Visit. \*Send Documentation.**  
Licensee shall provide a two and one-half (2) pound or greater ABC multiple purp
- **Wheelbarrow Full of Wood Posts and Items, Cardboard Boxes, Pool Ladder, Several Piles of Dog Poop, Etc. Accessible to Children in the Fenced Yard at Time of Visit.**  
The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds
- **Purse Accessible to Children in Livingroom and Candle Buring in Livingroom at Time of Visit.**  
The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds
