● 5 Important

Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were There Was Not a Drug Screen in the File for the Caregiver That Was Present. (2), The Garage Door Was Unlocked and Paint Was Accessible in the Garage. (1), and Items Labeled Keep Out or Reach of Children Were Accessible Under the Bathroom Sink. The Items Were Removed During the Visit. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **There Was Not a Drug Screen in the File for the Caregiver That Was Present.**

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available

● **The Garage Door Was Unlocked and Paint Was Accessible in the Garage.**

The licensee shall ensure that no conditions exist in the home or on the grounds

Feb 6, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **One Caregiver Did Not Have a Drug Screen in the File.**

A child care home shall, at no expense to the state, maintain and make available

Jan 25, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Items Labeled Keep Out or Reach of Children Were Accessible Under the Bathroom Sink. The Items Were Removed During the Visit.**

Caregiver shall keep poisonous or hazardous materials that would harm children,

● **Two Kids Did Not Have a Physical in the File.**

Within thirty (30) days of a childs admission, the licensee shall receive a writ
