Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were At Time of Inspection There Was One One-year-old Present, Napping on a Cot. Children Under 24 Months Have to Nap in a Crib or Pack-n-play. (1), Back Room Bathroom Door Does Not Have a Lock, Was Open and Items Labeled Keep Out of Reach of Children Accessible to Children: Baking Soda, Hand Soap, Toothpaste. Door Needs to Be Locked or Items Put Out of Reach. (1), and Three Staff Members Not Present Today Have Expired Fingerprints. However, Their Consents Are Still Valid. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
