Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Observed Multiple Children Have Their Diapers Changed Without the Diaper Pad Being Sanitized Between Diaper Changes. (1), Observed a Caregiver Come Inside From a Smoke Break Without Washing Hands Before Caring for an Infant. (1), and 4 Children Checked Did Not Have a Signed Parent Notice on File. (1).
