(2), At Time of Visit, One Volunteer (DS) Onsite and Working with Children Did Not Have Qualified Fingerprints on File with the Division. (1), and Each Childcare Provider Has Provided Evidence That They Have Not Been Named in the State Central Registry IC31-33-18. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
