(2), On Day of Visit, No Staff Had Current CPR Training (1), and At Least One Adult Shall Have Certification in CPR Applicable to All Age Groups Cared for and Is Present at All Times When a Child Is in Care. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **The Provider Shall Notify the Division: Not More Than Twenty-four (24) Hours After the Occurrence for Bodily Injury and Serious Bodily Injury**

Notify the division of injury or death

Oct 17, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Each Childcare Provider, Employee, or Volunteer, Caregiver Shall Have Current Certification in First Aid.**

● **Each Child Care Provider, Household Member, Employee, Volunteer Caregiver Shall Have an Intradermal Tuberculosis Test & Results Prior to Giving Care.**
