Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Small Throw Rugs Presenting Tripping Hazard in DPS C and DPS B, Need Removed or Taped Down. (1), One of Two Caregivers in Infant Room Has Expired Fingerprints So Can Not Be Counted in Ratio, So That Room Had One Qualified Caregiver to 6 Infants. Ratio for Infants Should Be 1:4. (1), and No Identified Quiet Space in 2 and Older Rooms. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **One of Two Caregivers in Infant Room Has Expired Fingerprints So Can Not Be Counted in Ratio, So That Room Had One Qualified Caregiver to 6 Infants. Ratio for Infants Should Be 1:4.**

- **Two Staff Working with Children Have Expired Fingerprints on File.**

Records, kept at the child care center, shall document the following for all cur

- **Small Throw Rugs Presenting Tripping Hazard in DPS C and DPS B, Need Removed or Taped Down.**

The center shall not use small rugs for floor covering

- **No Identified Quiet Space in 2 and Older Rooms.**

The following minimums shall be provided to each group to children two (2) years
