Each refrigerator and each freezer shall contain a clearly visible, accurate thermometer.

Description : In Room 6, the refrigerator has a temperature of 43 degrees.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (1) Poisonous or toxic materials shall not be stored with food. Medications requiring refrigeration shall be labeled and kept in locked storage in the refrigerator.

Description : In Rooms 6 and 7, Clorox wipes are stored with food. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (5) Dry, bulk foods which are not in their original, unopened containers shall be stored in metal, glass, food-grade sealable plastic bags, or food-grade plastic containers with tight-fitting covers and shall be labeled with the date and contents.

Description : There are peanut butter crackers out of the original packaging that are not stored properly and dated. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (J) medication administration training.

Description : Of the five staff files reviewed, one does not have a record of medication administration training to review.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (6) Cold water and hot water shall be supplied to lavatory fixtures accessible to children. Hot water shall maintain a minimum temperature of 90 degrees Fahrenheit and shall not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Description : In Room 7, the water temperature is 123.6 degrees.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (3) (B) individually-marked glasses or cups which shall be washed daily; or

Description : In Rooms 6 and 7, the individual water bottles used for drinking water are not all labeled. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (B) a designated shelter-in-place area, a designated off-premises relocation site, and evacuation routes for each area and for each site;

Description : There is not a designated off-premises relocation site. There is not an evacuation route for the off-premises relocation site.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (5) Each licensee shall ensure that each staff member practices, at least annually, the procedures for assisting the children to move to a designated shelter-in-place area and to a designated off-premises relocation site. The date and time of each practice and a list of all participating staff members shall be recorded and kept on file on the premises.
