K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) (7) Each licensee shall provide information to the parents of children in care about the benefits of annual, well-child health assessments for children under six years of age, and biennial health assessments for children six years of age and older. Each licensee shall also provide information about the importance of seeking medical advice when a child exhibits health problems. This information may be either given on a form provided by the department to the parent at the time the child is enrolled or posted in a conspicuous place, with copies of the form available to parents on request.

**Description : Well child health assessment is not shared with parents. Corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (E) prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions;

**Description : One staff member lacks training in prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions on file.**

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

**Description : Room 4: Disposables wipes and adult scissors are in an unlocked cabinet. Corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (d) (2) (D) before and after eating each snack and each meal; and

**Description : Room 4: Children did not have their hands washed after eating morning snack. Corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (B) a designated shelter-in-place area, a designated off-premises relocation site, and evacuation routes for each area and for each site;

**Description : Emergency plan does not include an evacuation route for the designated off-premises relocation site. Corrected at visit.**
