Description : A completed medical record is missing from three of twenty children's files reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (6) (B) A tornado drill shall be conducted monthly. A record of the date and time of each tornado drill and a record of each evacuation time shall be kept on file on the premises for one year.

Description : Tornado drills have not been conducted in several months.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (6) (A) A fire drill shall be conducted monthly. A record of the date and time of each fire drill and a record of each evacuation time shall be kept on file on the premises for one year.

Description : Fire drills have not been conducted in several months.

K.A.R. 28-4-127 Telephone; emergency medical treatment; reporting requirements. (b) (1) (A) Written permission of the parent or legal guardian for emergency medical treatment on a form that meets the requirements of the hospital or clinic where emergency medical care will be given; and

Description : Twenty of twenty children's files reviewed lacks updated EMR's on file.

(c) For each location a child is transported and for each off-premises trip, the destination, the time children leave the facility, the adults responsible for the children, and the estimated time of return shall be provided to parents and legal guardians.

Description : Twenty of twenty children's files reviewed lacks written permission to be off premise.

Description : Twenty of twenty children's files reviewed lacks written permission to be off premise on form supplied by the department.

Description : Parents and legal guardians were not notified in written form of cameras being used in the facility.



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
