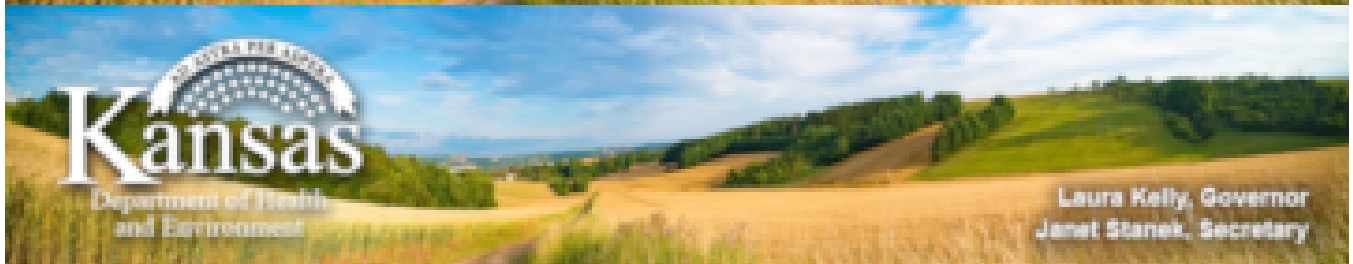

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (i) (3) (B) The bottle shall be labeled with the child's name, the contents, and the date and time prepared, and shall be used within 24 hours of the time of preparation on the label.

Description : Prepared bottles of formula in Infant 1 and Infant 2 are missing the contents, date, and time prepared. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (i) (4) (A) All breast milk shall be labeled with the child's name and the date and time expressed.

Description : Prepared bottles of breastmilk in Infant 1 and Infant 2 are missing the date and time expressed. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (2) All perishables and potentially hazardous foods shall be continuously maintained at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the refrigerator, or 10 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the freezer, with 0 degrees Fahrenheit recommended. Each refrigerator and each freezer shall contain a clearly visible, accurate thermometer.

Description : The refrigerator temperature in Tod 1 is 47, PreK is 42, and Jr Kindergarten is 46 degrees Fahrenheit. Partially corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (3) All foods stored in the refrigerator shall be covered. Food which is not in its original, unopened container shall be stored in metal, glass, food-grade sealable plastic bags, or foodgrade plastic containers with tightfitting covers and shall be labeled with the date and contents.

Description : Kitchen freezer: Pretzels and waffles are missing a label with the date and contents.

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) A completed medical record on the form provided by the department shall be on file at the facility for each child.

Description : Medical history form is incomplete for two children out of nine records reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) (5) Immunizations for each child in care shall be current as medically appropriate and shall be maintained current for protection from the diseases specified in K.A.R. 28-1-20(d). A record of each child's immunizations shall be obtained not later than 60 calendar days after the child's initial enrollment in a child care facility and shall be maintained on the child's medical record form.

Description : Current immunizations are not on file for one child out of nine records reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (E) prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions;

Description : Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions training is not on file for two staff members.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (F) building and premises safety, including identification of and protection from hazards that could cause bodily injury, including electrical hazards, bodies of water, and vehicular traffic;

Description : Building and premises safety training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (H) handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants, including blood and other bodily fluids or waste;

Description : Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants, including blood and other bodily fluids or waste training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (G) emergency preparedness and response planning for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster or a human-caused event, including violence at a facility;

Description : Emergency preparedness and response planning for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster or a human-caused event, including violence at a facility training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (A) Recognizing the signs of child abuse or neglect, knowledge on the prevention of child maltreatment, shaken baby syndrome, and abusive head trauma, and the reporting of suspected child abuse or neglect;

Description : Recognizing the signs of child abuse or neglect training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (B) basic child development, including:

Description : Basic child development training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (D) recognizing a sick child and prevention and control of infectious diseases, including immunizations;

Description : Recognizing a sick child and prevention and control of infectious diseases, including immunizations training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (J) medication administration training.

Description : Medication administration training is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-427 Program. (c) (4) The daily schedule shall be posted in each unit.

Description : Infant 1: Written daily schedule is not posted in the room. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (14) Walls shall be clean and free of cracks.

Description : Toddler 1: The east wall has paint that is peeling and chipped.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (18) The premises shall be maintained in good condition and shall be clean at all times, free from accumulated dirt and trash, and any evidence of vermin or rodent infestation. Each outdoor trash and garbage container shall be covered, and the contents shall be removed at least weekly.

Description : The interior gasket in the washing machines are filled with debris. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (6) Cold water and hot water shall be supplied to lavatory fixtures accessible to children. Hot water shall maintain a minimum temperature of

90 degrees Fahrenheit and shall not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Description : The following rooms did not have hot water at the child's hands washing sinks in: Infant 1 82.8, Infant 2 86.2, Toddler 1 89.1, Toddler 2 87.3, Early PreK 87.4, PreK 85.5, and Jr Kindergarten 86.4.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

Description : Jr. Kindergarten: Resin that says keep out of reach of children is stored in an unlocked drawer. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (i) (3) (B) (i) The child's first and last name;

Description : Prescription medication is on the premise not in the original pharmacy container labeled by the pharmacist.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (i) (2) (D) administer each medication according to the instructions on the label.

Description : Nonprescription medication was administered on 2/5/26 not according to the instructions on the label.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (C) procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions;

Description : The emergency plan does not include procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (B) a designated shelter-in-place area, a designated off-premises relocation site, and evacuation routes for each area and for each site;

Description : The emergency plan does not include an evacuation route for each area. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-127 Telephone; emergency medical treatment; reporting requirements. (a) A working telephone shall be on the premises and available for use at all times. Emergency telephone numbers shall be readily accessible or be posted next to the telephone for the police, fire department, ambulance, hospital or hospitals, and poison control center.

Description : Emergency telephone numbers are not readily accessible or posted. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-126 Health of individuals at least 16 years of age. (d) The health status form each tuberculosis test shall be recorded on forms provided by the department and shall be kept in each individual's record at the facility.

Description : Health status form is not on file for two staff members. Corrected at visit.

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
