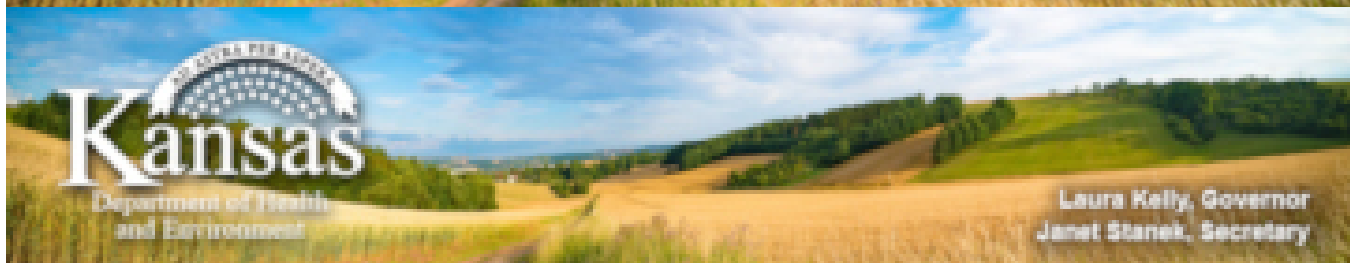

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (d) Hands shall be washed using soap and warm running water and dried with an individual towel or disposable product. When cloth towels and washcloths are used, they shall be labeled with the child's name, and shall be laundered at least weekly. When soap and running water are not readily available, an alcohol-based hand sanitizer may be used only by adults and, under adult supervision, by children two years of age and older.

Description : Individual towels for children unavailable in bathroom. Corrected at time of survey.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (D) procedures for responding to and preventing allergic reactions of individual children;

Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures for responding to and preventing an allergic reaction.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (B) a designated shelter-in-place area, a designated off-premises relocation site, and evacuation routes for each area and for each site;

Description : Emergency plans do not include an off-premises relocation site, including routes to each area.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (C) procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions;

Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures for special needs children.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (A) Procedures for emergencies likely to occur on or near the premises, including a fire, a weather-related event, a missing or runaway child, a chemical release, a utility failure, an intruder, an act of terrorism, a lockdown, and an unscheduled closing;

Description : Emergency plans do not include, blizzard, flood, missing child, chemical release, utility failure, intruder, act of terrorism, lockdown, and unscheduled closing plans.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (G) procedures for continuity of operations, including backing up or retrieving health and other required records; and

Description : Emergency plans do not include a continuity of care plan.

K.A.R. 28-4-126 Health of individuals at least 16 years of age. (d) The health status form each tuberculosis test shall be recorded on forms provided by the department and shall be kept in each individual's record at the facility.

Description : Record of negative TB skin test not on file for 1 provider.

K.A.R. 28-4-117 Health care requirements for children under 16 years of age and recordkeeping. (h) (4) written permission from the parent or legal guardian for emergency medical care and for the child to go off the premises as required by K.A.R. 28-4-124 and 28-4-127(b)(1)(A) and (B).

Description : Authorization for emergency medical care not on file for 5 children out of 6 records reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-117 Health care requirements for children under 16 years of age and

recordkeeping. (a) (2) a medical history obtained from the parent or legal guardian. Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall review with each child's parent or legal guardian that child's medical history at least once every 12 months.

Description : Medical history form not on file for 5 children out of 6 records reviewed

K.A.R. 28-4-116a Napping and sleeping. (b) (1) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall develop a written plan for safe sleep practices and implement safe sleep practices for children in care who are napping or sleeping.

Description : Safe sleep plan indicates rooms will be dimly lit. Corrected at time of survey.

K.A.R. 28-4-116 Daily care of children. (d) (1) (D) (i) All breast milk shall be labeled with the child's name and the time and date expressed.

Description : Bottle that had contained breast milk not labeled with child's name.

Breast milk bags not labeled with child's name and time expressed.

K.A.R. 28-4-116 Daily care of children. (d) (1) (C) (ii) Each bottle shall be labeled with the child's name, the contents, and the time and date prepared, and shall be used within 24 hours of the time of preparation on the label.

Description : Bottle that had contained formula not labeled with child's name, contents, and the time and date prepared.

K.A.R. 28-4-116 Daily care of children. (d) (11) Tableware shall be washed, rinsed, and air-dried or placed in a dishwasher after each meal.

Description : Two bottles that had contained breast milk and formula left in playpen and on table in living room.

K.A.R. 28-4-115a Supervision. (a) (1) (B) the manner in which supervision will be provided; and

Description : Supervision plan does not include manner in which supervision will be provided.

K.A.R. 28-4-115a Supervision. (a) (1) (A) A description of the rooms, levels, or areas of the facility including indoor and outdoor areas in which the child will participate in activities, have snacks or meals, nap, or sleep;

Description : Supervision plan does not include activities to be done in each child care area.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (g) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals, and all bodily care products containing alcohol or bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage or stored out of reach of children under six years of age. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a sink.

Description : Household cleaners and bodily care products bearing child warning labels accessible to children in kitchen, bathroom, hallway, and living room.

Corrected a time of survey.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (c) (17) has interior and exterior surfaces of the facility that are free from peeling, chipping, cracking, scaling, and loose paint.

Description : Peeling and flaking exterior paint on house and ground in outdoor play

area.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (c) (6) has kitchen and outdoor trash and garbage in covered containers or in tied plastic bags;

Description : Kitchen trash uncovered.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (c) (8) has each electrical outlet covered or inaccessible to prevent easy access by a child when the outlet is not in use;

Description : Two electrical outlets uncovered in playroom.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (g) (2) All medications shall be in locked storage or stored out of the reach of children under 10 years of age.

Description : Medication unlocked and accessible to children on bathroom counter.

Corrected at time of survey.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (c) (11) (B) has each stairway guarded by a secured door or gated to prevent unsupervised access by the child, including a latching device that an adult can open readily in an emergency;

Description : Basement stairway unguarded with children under 2.5 years of age present. Corrected at time of survey.
