K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (c) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall maintain first-aid supplies in a first-aid kit, carrying case, box, or other container. The first-aid supplies shall include the following:

**Description : An ace bandage, 4x4 gauze pads and a bottle of water are not included in the first aid kit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) Each applicant, each applicant with a temporary permit, and each licensee shall develop and implement a written emergency plan to provide for the safety of children and staff members in emergencies. The emergency plan shall include the following information:

**Description : A written emergency plan has not been developed.**

K.A.R. 28-4-127 Telephone; emergency medical treatment; reporting requirements. (a) A working telephone shall be on the premises and available for use at all times. Emergency telephone numbers shall be readily accessible or be posted next to the telephone for the police, fire department, ambulance, hospital or hospitals, and poison control center.

**Description : Emergency telephone numbers are not readily accessible or posted.**

K.A.R. 28-4-126 Health of individuals at least 16 years of age. (b) Each individual at least 16 years of age who is caring for children shall attest to that individual's health status on a form supplied by the department or approved by the secretary.

**Description : A health status form is not on file for one individual.**

K.A.R. 28-4-117 Health care requirements for children under 16 years of age and recordkeeping. (a) A completed medical record on the form provided by the department shall be on file for each child under 10 years of age enrolled for care and for each child under 16 years of age living in the child care facility and shall include the following:

**Description : A medical record is not on file for three children.**

K.A.R. 28-4-116a Napping and sleeping. (b) (1) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall develop a written plan for safe sleep practices and implement safe sleep practices for children in care who are napping or sleeping.

**Description : Safe sleep practices are not developed for children 12 months and older.**

K.A.R. 28-4-115a Supervision. (a) (1) (A) A description of the rooms, levels, or areas of the facility including indoor and outdoor areas in which the child will participate in activities, have snacks or meals, nap, or sleep;

**Description : A description of the rooms, levels, or areas of the facility, including indoor and outdoor areas in which children will participate in activities, have snacks or meals, nap, or sleep is not included in the supervision plan.**

K.A.R. 28-4-114a Initial and ongoing professional development training. (c) (2) Each applicant and each applicant with a temporary permit shall obtain the certifications not later than 30 calendar days after submitting an application for a license.

**Description : Applicant has not completed pediatric first aid and pediatric CPR certifications within 30 days of submitting an application for a license when application was submitted on 8/13/25..**



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
