Description : There is dog feces in the outdoor play area accessible to children.

K.A.R. 28-4-117 Health care requirements for children under 16 years of age and recordkeeping. (c) Immunizations for each child, including each child of the provider under 16 years of age shall be current as medically appropriate and shall be maintained current for protection from the diseases specified in K.A.R. 28-1-20(d). A record of each child's immunizations shall be obtained not later than 60 calendar days after the child's initial enrollment in a child care facility and shall be maintained on the child's medical record.

Description : One of seven child files reviewed lack current immunizations.

K.A.R. 28-4-116a Napping and sleeping. (b) (1) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall develop a written plan for safe sleep practices and implement safe sleep practices for children in care who are napping or sleeping.

Description : The safe sleep policy lacks detail for all ages of children in care.

K.A.R. 28-4-115 Facility. (c) (8) has each electrical outlet covered or inaccessible to prevent easy access by a child when the outlet is not in use;

Description : One outlet is uncovered in the living room and accessible to children in care. Corrected at the time of the survey.
