K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (i) (4) (A) All breast milk shall be labeled with the child's name and the date and time expressed.

Description : In Room 102 and 124, the breast milk bottles do not have the time expressed listed. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (i) (3) (B) The bottle shall be labeled with the child's name, the contents, and the date and time prepared, and shall be used within 24 hours of the time of preparation on the label.

Description : In Room 102 and 124, the formula bottles do not have the time prepared listed. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-436 Child care centers: napping and sleeping. (c) (6) Each crib and each playpen shall have a firm, tightfitting mattress and a fitted sheet. The mattress shall be set at its lowest point when any child using the crib or playpen becomes able to either sit up or to pull up to a standing position inside the crib or playpen, whichever occurs first, to ensure that the child cannot climb out of the crib or playpen.

Description : In Rooms 102 and 124, several sheets are not firm and tightfitting on the mattress. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) (2) Each medical record shall include a medical history obtained from the parent or legal guardian. Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall review with each child's parent or legal guardian that child's medical history at least once every 12 months.

Description : Medical history is not on the updated form for five children out of fourteen records reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (e) (4) In each licensure year, each staff member counted in the staff-child ratio and each volunteer counted in the staff-child ratio shall complete 16 clock-hours of professional development training based on the staff member's or volunteer's job responsibilities and the training needs identified by the program director. Four of the 16 clock-hours shall include the subject areas specified in paragraphs (b)(2)(A), (b)(2)(C) through (J), or subsection (c).

Description : Sixteen hours of professional development training is incomplete for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (c) (1) Each staff member counted in the staff-child ratio, each volunteer counted in the staff-child ratio, and each program director shall obtain certification in pediatric first aid and in pediatric CPR as specified in this subsection either before the date of employment or volunteering or not later than 30 calendar days after the date of employment or volunteering.

Description : Pediatric first aid and CPR is not on file for one staff member.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

Description : In Room 102, there are wipes in a container under a crib, not in locked storage. Corrected at visit. Most classrooms do not keep their toothpaste in locked storage. The toothpaste reads "Keep Out of Reach of Children". Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (6) Cold water and hot water shall be supplied to lavatory fixtures accessible to children. Hot water shall maintain a minimum temperature of 90 degrees Fahrenheit and shall not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Description : Room 120 has a water temperature of 84.9. Room 125 has a water temperature of 79.2.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (3) (B) individually-marked glasses or cups which shall be washed daily; or

Description : In Rooms 103, 104, 111, 112, and 115, several water bottles are not labeled with an individual child's name. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (d) (1) (C) after toileting, diapering, assisting a child with toileting, or handling any bodily fluids;

Description : In Room 116, a staff member did not wash her hands after diapering a child. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (5) Each licensee shall ensure that each staff member practices, at least annually, the procedures for assisting the children to move to a designated shelter-in-place area and to a designated off-premises relocation site. The date and time of each practice and a list of all participating staff members shall be recorded and kept on file on the premises.

Description : There is not a record of the date, time, or list of participants for practicing the procedures for assisting children to move to their designated off-premises relocation site.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (B) a designated shelter-in-place area, a designated off-premises relocation site, and evacuation routes for each area and for each site;

Description : There is not an evacuation route for the off-premises relocation site. Corrected at visit.
