K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (2) All perishables and potentially hazardous foods shall be continuously maintained at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the refrigerator, or 10 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the freezer, with 0 degrees Fahrenheit recommended. Each refrigerator and each freezer shall contain a clearly visible, accurate thermometer.

Description : Kitchen: Both freezers are lacking thermometers.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (a) (3) practices sanitary methods of food handling and storage; and

Description : Children are eating lunch outside on the tables and the food is not covered when transported from the kitchen to the outside.

K.A.R. 28-4-436 Child care centers: napping and sleeping. (c) (11) Each piece of sleeping equipment shall be labeled and designated for use by a single child.

Description : None of the folding cots that children use for napping are labeled and designated for use by a single child.

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) (2) Each medical record shall include a medical history obtained from the parent or legal guardian. Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall review with each child's parent or legal guardian that child's medical history at least once every 12 months.

Description : One child in care does not have a medical record on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (a) (2) Each licensee shall provide orientation to each program director not later than seven calendar days after the date of employment and before the program director is given sole responsibility for implementing and supervising the program.

Description : Eight staff members have incomplete orientation training on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (1) Each staff member who is counted in the staff-child ratio, each volunteer who is counted in the staff-child ratio, and each program director shall complete health and safety training either before employment or volunteering or not later than 30 calendar days after the date of employment or volunteering. Each staff member shall complete the training before being given sole responsibility for the care and supervision of children.

Description : Two staff members lack health and safety training within their first 30 days of employment. One staff member lacks health and safety training on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-427 Program. (c) (2) Written lesson plans for each unit shall be made accessible to parents, staff, and the secretary's designee.

Description : Room B and C: Lesson plans are not accessible.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (6) Cold water and hot water shall be supplied to lavatory fixtures accessible to children. Hot water shall maintain a minimum temperature of 90 degrees Fahrenheit and shall not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Description : Room A: Hot water temperature at two children's hand sinks is 88.3 degrees F and 87.4 degrees F.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (15) Electrical outlets shall be covered or inaccessible to prevent access by a child when not in use.

Description : Room B: There is an outlet uncovered on a power strip. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (18) The premises shall be maintained in good condition and shall be clean at all times, free from accumulated dirt and trash, and any evidence of vermin or rodent infestation. Each outdoor trash and garbage container shall be covered, and the contents shall be removed at least weekly.

Description : Room B: The diaper changing table has visible debris. Kitchen and basement: The interior of the refrigerators and freezers have dried on food soil; not clean. Room B: There are two vinyl chairs and a brown couch with the vinyl coating is peeling off, not in good repair. The top of the washing machine has visible debris; not clean.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (23) Dangerous instruments including sharp or pointed objects, shall be in locked storage.

Description : Room A: Adult scissors on a shelf. Room C: Adults scissors and a knife on a shelf. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

Description : Room A: There is a cabinet that the latch is broken exposing numerous chemicals: body lotion, petroleum jelly, sunscreen, Cortizone 10, a Bic lighter, metal polish, and a laxative for a child. There is an adult restroom door that is unlocked in Room A and there are numerous chemicals accessible to children: Naproxen sodium, Ibuprofen, Tums, Poison ivy ointment, disinfecting spray, body lotion, hair gel, antibiotic ointment. Room B: There are cleaners hanging on a hook in the bathroom. Partial correction at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (i) (3) (B) keep each medication in the original container labeled by a pharmacist, with the following information:

Description : A child in care has an inhaler on premise and it is not in the original pharmacy container.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (d) (2) (C) after toileting, being diapered, or changing wet or soiled clothing;

Description : Room A: A child did not have her hands washed after using the toilet. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (i) (2) (A) Obtain written permission from each child's parent or legal guardian before administering medication to that child;

Description : There is a child in care that has a laxative on premise and there is not parental permission and a doctor's note to administer on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (6) (B) A tornado drill shall be conducted monthly. A record of the date and time of each tornado drill and a record of each

evacuation time shall be kept on file on the premises for one year.

Description : Tornado drills not recorded for November & December 2024 and January & February 2025.

K.A.R. 28-4-126 Health of individuals at least 16 years of age. (c) (1) Each individual at least 16 years of age who is living, working, or regularly volunteering in the facility shall have a record of a negative tuberculosis test or x-ray obtained not more than two years before the date of employment or initial application for a license or not later than 30 days after the date of employment or initial application.

Description : One volunteer and one staff member lack negative TB test results on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-125 Background checks. (a) (3) before allowing any individual to work, regularly volunteer, or reside in the facility and before allowing any individual whose activities involve either supervised or unsupervised access to children to be in the facility;

Description : Facility did not submit identifying information for one volunteer as required to complete background check.
