K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (5) Dry, bulk foods which are not in their original, unopened containers shall be stored in metal, glass, food-grade sealable plastic bags, or food-grade plastic containers with tight-fitting covers and shall be labeled with the date and contents.

Description : Multiple cereals stored in plastic containers, not in their original containers, are not labeled with the date. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (p) (2) All perishables and potentially hazardous foods shall be continuously maintained at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the refrigerator, or 10 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the freezer, with 0 degrees Fahrenheit recommended. Each refrigerator and each freezer shall contain a clearly visible, accurate thermometer.

Description : The refrigerator thermometer is not working properly.

K.A.R. 28-4-436 Child care centers: napping and sleeping. (b) (4) Each child who is 12 months of age or older shall nap or sleep on a cot or pad. Pads shall be used only over carpet.

Description : Toddler room: Toddlers are sleeping in pack and plays and not sleeping on a cot or pad.

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) A completed medical record on the form provided by the department shall be on file at the facility for each child.

Description : Medical record is not on file for one child out of 13 records reviewed.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (E) prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions;

Description : Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions training is not on file for one staff.

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (2) (H) handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants, including blood and other bodily fluids or waste;

Description : Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants, including blood and other bodily fluids or waste training is not on file for one staff.

K.A.R. 28-4-426 Administration. (d) (6) work references.

Description : Work references are not on file for one staff. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (c) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall maintain first-aid supplies in a first-aid kit, carrying case, box, or other container. The first-aid supplies shall include the following:

Description : The first-aid kit is lacking a manual.

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (C) procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions;

Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical

conditions.
