Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a sink.

Description : Swifter mop pads located in the bathroom are not in locked storage and are within reach of children. Corrected at visit.

Description : All required training documentation is not available for substitute and volunteer unsupervised.
