(p) (2) All perishables and potentially hazardous foods shall be continuously maintained at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the refrigerator, or 10 degrees Fahrenheit or lower in the freezer, with 0 degrees Fahrenheit recommended. Each refrigerator and each freezer shall contain a clearly visible, accurate thermometer.

Description : The refrigerator in Room 107.2 is maintained at 54 degrees.

K.A.R. 28-4-437 Child care centers: outside area. (d) The outdoor play space shall be well drained and free of hazards.

Description : There is a tub on the Toddler playground that is cracked and has sharp edges. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (23) Dangerous instruments including sharp or pointed objects, shall be in locked storage.

Description : Adult scissors are not in locked storage in Room 114. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (25) The interior and exterior surfaces of the facility shall be free from peeling, chipping, cracking, scaling, and loose paint.

Description : There is peeling paint in Rooms 107.2, 108, 109.2, 114, 111 and 110.

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

Description : The following are out of locked storage throughout the center; Room 107.1: diaper wipes labeled keep out of reach of children Room 102: air freshener, diaper wipes labeled keep out of reach of children Room 111: air freshener, sunscreen Room 110: toothpaste Hallway closet: several air fresheners, disinfectant and bottles of bleach All corrected at visit

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (18) The premises shall be maintained in good condition and shall be clean at all times, free from accumulated dirt and trash, and any evidence of vermin or rodent infestation. Each outdoor trash and garbage container shall be covered, and the contents shall be removed at least weekly.

Description : The following are not in good condition or clean throughout the center; Room 108: adhesive residue on the bookshelf, baseboards are cracked Room 109.1: a lid stored in the bathroom is rusted (Corrected at visit) Room 111: the bookshelf is splintered, the baseboard is cracked and damaged Room 110: the baseboard is cracked and damaged

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (15) Electrical outlets shall be covered or inaccessible to prevent access by a child when not in use.

Description : The electrical outlet in Room 107.2 is not covered. Corrected at visit.

K.A.R. 28-4-132 Child care practices. (g) (7) (A) Have a moisture-proof, nonabsorbent, smooth surface that is undamaged, does not trap soil, and is easily cleaned;

Description : The diaper changing pad is torn in Room 107.2.

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
