Description : Two of 12 children enrolled do not have an emergency medical treatment form on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-125 Background checks. (a) (3) before allowing any individual to work, regularly volunteer, or reside in the facility and before allowing any individual whose activities involve either supervised or unsupervised access to children to be in the facility;

Description : Facility did not submit identifying information for two individuals as required to complete background checks.

K.A.R. 28-4-117 Health care requirements for children under 16 years of age and recordkeeping. (a) A completed medical record on the form provided by the department shall be on file for each child under 10 years of age enrolled for care and for each child under 16 years of age living in the child care facility and shall include the following:

Description : Two of 12 children do not have a completed medical record on file.

K.A.R. 28-4-116 Daily care of children. (c) No provider shall use tobacco products while providing direct physical care to children. Smoking in any room, enclosed area, or other enclosed space on the premises shall be prohibited when children are in care pursuant to K.S.A. 65-530, and amendments thereto.

Description : Provider was observed vaping while providing direct care to children outside.

K.A.R. 28-4-116 Daily care of children. (d) (11) Tableware shall be washed, rinsed, and air-dried or placed in a dishwasher after each meal.

Description : Tableware from breakfast and the evening meal from yesterday are in the sink and have not been washed.

K.A.R. 28-4-114 Applicant; licensee. (h) (1) The maximum number of children in each age category, including children under 10 years of age related to the applicant with a temporary permit, the licensee, or any other provider, does not exceed the maximum number of children in each age category as specified in subsection (e), except as specified in paragraph (h)(3).

Description : The maximum number of children is exceeded when one provider is present with three children under 12 months of age, seven children 12 months to 5 years (over by four children) and two children 5 years to 10 years of age.
