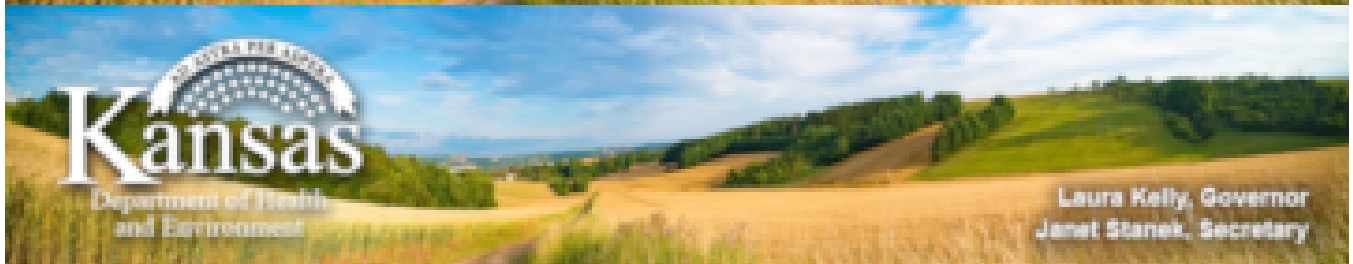

K.A.R. 28-4-439 Child care centers: food service. (i) (4) (A) All breast milk shall be labeled with the child's name and the date and time expressed.

**Description : There are bottles and bags of breastmilk not labeled with the time expressed in room 6.**

K.A.R. 28-4-437 Child care centers: outside area. (b) The boundaries of outdoor play space shall be enclosed with a fence not less than four feet high.

**Description : The South side of the playground fence is measuring at approximately 46.5 inches.**

K.A.R. 28-4-430 Health practices; illness and abuse; general health requirements for staff. (a) (2) Each medical record shall include a medical history obtained from the parent or legal guardian. Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall review with each child's parent or legal guardian that child's medical history at least once every 12 months.

**Description : Of the eleven files reviewed for children in care, three Medical Record: History forms are not complete.**

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (b) (1) Each staff member who is counted in the staff-child ratio, each volunteer who is counted in the staff-child ratio, and each program director shall complete health and safety training either before employment or volunteering or not later than 30 calendar days after the date of employment or volunteering. Each staff member shall complete the training before being given sole responsibility for the care and supervision of children.

**Description : Of the fourteen current staff records reviewed, one staff member does not have health and safety training completed.**

K.A.R. 28-4-428a Education and training requirements. (d) Infant care training. In addition to the training specified in paragraphs (a) through (c) of this regulation, each lead teacher in an infant unit shall complete four hours of professional development training in an infant-specific subject either before the date of employment or volunteering or not later than 30 calendar days after the date of employment or volunteering.

**Description : Two current staff members who serve as leads in infant classrooms do not have infant care training on file.**

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (e) (1) All household supplies, cleaning supplies, dangerous chemicals and all bodily care products bearing warning labels to keep out of reach of children shall be in locked storage, except that hand sanitizers, disinfectant solutions used daily to disinfect surfaces, and diapering supplies may be kept unlocked at least five feet above the floor and out of reach of children. Soap used for hand washing may be kept unlocked and placed on the back of the counter by a bathroom or sink.

**Description : Room 1: Sunscreen is stored out of locked storage. Room 4: Clorox wipes are stored on a low shelf in the restroom. Room 6: A Swiffer mop has the cleaner stored in it out of locked storage. All corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (b) (6) Cold water and hot water shall be supplied to lavatory fixtures accessible to children. Hot water shall maintain a minimum temperature of 90 degrees Fahrenheit and shall not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

**Description : There is no hot water available for rooms 4, 5, 6, and 8. The hot water**

**exceeds 120 degrees in room 7. Partial correction at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (23) Dangerous instruments including sharp or pointed objects, shall be in locked storage.

**Description : Sharp adult scissors are stored on a shelf out of locked storage.**

**Corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-423 Physical plant. (a) (15) Electrical outlets shall be covered or inaccessible to prevent access by a child when not in use.

**Description : Electrical outlet is not covered in room 8. Corrected at visit.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (A) Procedures for emergencies likely to occur on or near the premises, including a fire, a weather-related event, a missing or runaway child, a chemical release, a utility failure, an intruder, an act of terrorism, a lockdown, and an unscheduled closing;

**Description : The emergency plans do not include an unscheduled closing.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (C) procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions;

**Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures to meet the needs of individual children, including each child with special needs and chronic medical conditions.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (D) procedures for responding to and preventing allergic reactions of individual children;

**Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures for responding to and preventing allergic reactions of individual children.**

**Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures for reuniting each child with each parent or adult responsible for the child.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (a) (1) (E) procedures for notifying each parent or adult responsible for a child of any off-premises relocation;

**Description : Emergency plans do not include procedures for notifying each parent or adult responsible for a child of any off-premises relocation.**

K.A.R. 28-4-128 Safety and emergency procedures. (c) Each applicant with a temporary permit and each licensee shall maintain first-aid supplies in a first-aid kit, carrying case, box, or other container. The first-aid supplies shall include the following:

**Description : The first aid kit is lacking an elastic bandage.**

K.A.R. 28-4-126 Health of individuals at least 16 years of age. (c) (1) Each individual at least 16 years of age who is living, working, or regularly volunteering in the facility shall have a record of a negative tuberculosis test or x-ray obtained not more than two years before the date of employment or initial application for a license or not later than 30 days after the date of employment or initial application.

**Description : Of the fourteen current staff records reviewed, two staff members do not have a record of a negative tb test or x-ray.**

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
