Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were 922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

(4) A Child Shall:

(a) Be Helped with Personal Care and Cleanliness Based Upon His or Her Developmental Skills;

(b) Except as Established in Paragraph (C) of This Subsection, Wash His or Her Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running water:

1. A. Upon Arrival at the Center; Or

b. Within Thirty (30) Minutes of Arrival for School-age children;

3. After Toileting or Diaper change;

pillows Were Later Used as Pillows for Three (3) Children D (1), and 922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

1. Completed and Signed by the Child's parent;

2. Retained on File on the First Day the Child Attends the Child-care Center; and

a. Identifying Information About the Child, Which Includes, at a Minimum, the Child's Name, Address, and Date of Birth;

b. Contact Information to Enable a Person in Charge to Contact the Child's:

(i) Parent at the Parent's Home or Place of Empl (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
